Test Strategies

reading is the best preparation (60 minutes uninterrupted)

- read the question(s) first
- read everything: pictures, charts, graphs, tables, headings, subheadings
- hi-light key words
- eliminate distractors
- substitute answer choices - choose the one that makes the most sense
- if you're not sure - guess
- if it doesn't make sense - go back and reread
- stretch your arms/wiggle your fingers
- answer every question
- answer all choices that apply
- check your work
- watch the clock
- be positive
